It's time to play again at the Children's Museum of Evansville!

We are committed to providing a healthy and safe environment. In preparation for reopening, modifications have been made to our buildings and exhibits. New practices and protocols have been put in place that follow the local, state and CDC guidelines.

What to expect:

- Limited occupancy and 2-hour timed entry sessions will be held from 9-11 am, 11:30 am-1:30 pm, and 2:00-4:00 pm.
- Advance online reservations for tickets are required for everyone, including members. Of course, visits are free for members! Reservations can be made at www.cmoekids.org. For touchless scanning and quick entry upon arrive, please bring your electronic ticket.
- Upon making reservations, visitors will be asked to attest to everyone in their family being COVID-19 symptom free and to abide by our code of conduct, confirming that they will follow social distancing requirements.
- Exhibits have been divided into play zones that provide for social distancing in all galleries.
- Expanding cleaning protocols to include: daily before facility opens, after facility closes, cleaning after each timed entry session and during the 30 minutes between each timed entry session.
- Children will receive a mini-activity kit, providing one-user only supplies that can be used throughout their visit.
- Increased hand sanitation stations and social distancing floor markers throughout the facility.
- All staff will be required to complete a daily health screening prior to each shift and will wear face coverings.
- Visitors over 3 years of age will be required to wear a mask/face covering.
